General licence for the movement of poultry carcases for disposal from premises within the Protection Zone (PZ) or Surveillance Zone (SZ)

I, the undersigned, being an Inspector of the Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs ("the Department"), for the purposes of the Avian Influenza and Influenza of Avian Origin in Mammals Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007 grant the following licence, subject to the following conditions

This licence authorises the movement of poultry carcases from premises within a Surveillance Zone (SZ) or Protection Zone (PZ) to other premises outside the zone.

Conditions applying to all movements covered by this licence

- 1. Poultry carcases may be moved under this licence provided that immediately prior to each movement / removal of any poultry carcase/s the flock keeper inspects any live poultry on the premises to check that they show no clinical signs that could be associated with Avian Influenza.
- 2. There must be no live poultry on the premises of destination.
- 3. Record keeping systems must be in place to ensure that all movements of poultry carcases can be traced from the premises of origin to the premises of destination. The record must include name and address of premises of destination, quantity and identity (i.e. flock number) of poultry carcases moved, date and time of movement, full contact details in relation to movement including vehicle registration, etc
- 4. The transfer of carcases must be at the perimeter of the premises. Collection vehicles are not permitted to enter the holding.
- 5. After unloading the poultry carcases at the premises of destination, the parts of the vehicle and any equipment used to transport anything which might be contaminated with mud, slurry, poultry faeces, excretions, feathers, litter, egg shell or similar matter must be cleansed and disinfected on site.
- 6. Cleansing and disinfection must be in accordance with article 66(5) of the Avian Influenza and Influenza of Avian Origin in Mammals Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007.
- 7. All persons to whom this licence applies shall:
 - Not enter or leave premises wearing clothing or footwear which is visibly soiled with mud, animal or bird faeces or any similar matter;
 - Cleanse and disinfect their footwear on leaving premises within the controlled zone; and
 - Take all other reasonable precautions to avoid the transfer of contamination between premises.
