- 1. In accordance with articles 4(1)(f) and 36(3) of the Avian Influenza and Influenza of Avian Origin in Mammals (NI) 2007, the Department makes this declaration to revoke the Surveillance Zone that was declared at 16.30 on 1 February 2021
- 2. This revocation takes effect from 16.030 on 10 February 2021, thereby ending the measures imposed in the 10 kilometre Surveillance Zone centred on Clough, County Antrim declared on 01 February 2021, which had replaced the original declaration of a Protection and Surveillance zone dated 6 January 2020.
